## RESOURCEFULNESS: Using what you have to get the job done.

There are many ways to approach getting the job done. The typical approach is to evaluate what needs to be done and what is required to do it.

**Limits are recognized and overcome.** Discouragement is a large hurdle to clear when there doesn't seem to be enough available to get the job done. When the limitations are overcome, the accomplishment seems even sweeter.

**Creativity is encouraged.** Producing a solution from limited materials fuels a child's awareness of his or her creativity. Success is a natural encouragement for future efforts.

**The process is valued as much as the product.** The most valuable aspect of doing a job is building a set of problem-solving tools. Personal confidence grows when children see how previously developed methods from other areas of their lives can be applied to new situations.
